**Remarks**

Inspection of kennel was completed.  
There was a total of 206 adults and 81 pups on the premises at the time of the inspection.  
The kennel license for 2008 was displayed, 2009 license application was received by BDLE and is pending.  
Exemption letter to keep records on "unofficial" forms and rabies certification letter were both viewed.  
The inspection was performed with Warden Cole Warminsky.

**ACT 207(b):**

21.21a: The majority of the pens, on the outdoor portion, contained large openings that had sharp points where the wire had been cut posing a threat of injury to the dogs. The dogs could either puncture or cut any part of their body or get their mouth on it and injure the interior of their mouth. These holes also pose a problem of not containing the dogs, during the inspection there was a dog found outside a pen walking under the outside portions of the runs. Many of the dogs during the inspection would sit with their head/upper half of body outside of the pen.

This warden directs: Any sharp edges of wire around the opening of these holes be capped or grind down smooth and doors be put to close off the holes.



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21.21b: There were portions of interior surfaces of pens that had been scratched and the wood was exposed.

This warden directs: Seal or cover any and all exposed wood that the dogs may come in contact with.

21.24d: (1) In the puppy room there was at least one pen viewed that had the wire coating coming off. (3) There were pens that had wire flooring that allowed the dogs feet to fall through the openings in the floor. This also poses a threat of injury to the dogs that if their legs fall through they could either get stuck or possibly result in a broken bone.

This warden directs: (1) Replace or cover any wire flooring that has the vinyl coating coming off or already removed. (3) Replace the wire flooring where the dogs feet fall through with flooring that has smaller opening holes.

21.28a: During the inspection there was food, accessible by the dogs, contaminated with feces.

This warden directs: Any contamination in the food must be removed as often as necessary to keep the food free from said contamination.

21.28c: There were feeders that were either one or more of the following: contaminated with dog feces, filled with mouse feces, or dirty/caked with feed.

This warden directs: Feeders need to be accessible to the dogs but located to avoid contamination with feces, kept clean, and sanitized regularly to prevent caking of feed.

21.29c: There were large amounts of mouse feces found not only covering the entire bottom of empty feeders but along some walls and in corners throughout the buildings and grounds of the kennel. This is indicative of an ineffective program against the ingress of pests and unsanitary environmental sanitation in the kennel.

This warden directs: Implement a program to prevent an infestation of pests including but not limited to cleaning and keeping the grounds in good repair.

ACT 207(c):

21.41a: The records viewed were incomplete and did not illustrate an accurate count of the number of dogs kept within the kennel. Some of the information incomplete was, but not limited to, date of birth, date acquired, description of dog, etc.

This warden directs: Review and update all records with regards to and including all required information and an accurate count of the dogs that are in the kennel.

455.8: The kennel owner is certified to administer rabies vaccine. The rabies records were missing information that is required, many dogs were overdue for a follow-up vaccination, and when compared to the records of dogs in kennel there were some that did not have a rabies vaccination at all or there were dogs listed on the rabies records to have received a vaccination but it could not be determined which exact dog it was. Also, upon reviewing the rabies records there were many dogs that were not given their first shot until 4, 5 or even 6 months of age.

This warden directs: The rabies records need to be reviewed and matched up accordingly with each dog (3 months of age or older) that is required to have a vaccination. Any and all dogs that are overdue must receive a rabies vaccine. Any and all dogs that have not had a rabies vaccination must receive one. Pups that turn 3 months of age should receive a vaccination on that date.

ACT 401(c): Prior to the inspection, in an attempt to make contact with the kennel owner, this officer and Warminsky were informed they would have to leave the premises to meet the kennel owner at another property. Upon returning to the state vehicle 2 others of the kennel owner's family were viewed entering the kennel and making adjustments prior to the start of the inspection. This officer and Warminsky remained at the kennel while another member of the family went to get the kennel owner from the other property. During the inspection there were 2 persons in the kennel feeding the dogs and cleaning the kennel. These actions, therefore, were interfering with the duties of the officers in efforts to enforce the law.

This warden directs: Upon arrival of state dog wardens to the premises no persons shall perform any actions that would alter the condition of the kennel at the time of the requested inspection, prior to or during, to prevent this interference of enforcing the law.

21.30: Condition of Dogs: During the inspection there were several dogs viewed that had matting of the coat and excessively long nails. There was also a young Bulldog type breed that was viewed walking on its pasterns and discharge coming from its nose.

ACT402(d): An order of veterinary care was placed on the young Bulldog type breed. The examination is to be conducted before 2/9/2009.

This warden directs: Dogs with matted coats should be clipped to remove said mats. The nails on the dogs should be trimmed. Any dogs that show signs of infectious/contagious disease or abnormal conditions should be seen by a vet, and proof of care should be kept for verification.

**Remarks**

Recheck inspection of kennel was completed. There were a total of 151 adults and 28 puppies on the premises at the time of the inspection. The kennel license for 2008 was displayed. The 2009 license application has been received by BDLE and is pending. The exemption letter to keep records on "unofficial" forms and rabies certification letter were both viewed by this warden. The inspection was performed with Warden Cole Warminsky and Warden Megan Caskey.

3 P.S. § 455.8

The kennel owner is certified to administer rabies vaccine. The rabies records were missing information that is required. Upon reviewing the rabies records, the count for the number of dogs (3 months of age or older) that should have had a vaccination was not accurate. There was one (1) dog listed as having a rabies vaccination that was removed from the kennel at a prior date.

This warden directs: Ensure that all information required by law is completed on rabies vaccinations records. Any dog that is removed from the kennel shall be marked off of the rabies vaccinations records. The records of dogs in kennel should be reviewed along side of the rabies vaccination records to ensure that all dogs have received a rabies vaccination and the amount of dogs 3 mos or older equals the amount on the



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rabies records with a current vaccination.

ACT 207(b) / REG 21.21a

The holes that were viewed during the prior inspection were no longer present. The front of the cages, where the holes were located, were viewed to either be a solid wire wall (i.e., there was no direct access to the outside portion of the run other than through the top) or the entire bottom half of the wall had been removed and reattached with clamps to make it a door. The portions where the doors were created had sharp edges and points. The doors were not flush with the other walls of the run which created gaps at the top and the bottom of the doors. During the inspection, dogs were viewed putting their head up through the openings (between the doors and the upper portion walls) or they were viewed with their feet/legs falling through the bottom, between the door and the run floor. These gaps around the doors and any and all sharp edges from the clipped/cut wire throughout the kennel pose a threat of injury to the dogs. During the inspection this Warden injured her right index finger on the sharp edges of the wire. There were two pens where the top portion of the door frame for the indoor/outdoor access was falling down. The caulking that seals the corners and edges of the interior dog boxes was coming off/peeling away from the edge of the box. The dogs could chew off said caulking and ingest the material.

This warden directs: Any and all sharp edges of wire located throughout the kennel shall be capped or grinded down smooth and the doors on the outside portions of the runs shall be repaired to close the gaps. The door frames to indoor/outdoor portions need to be replaced or repaired. The caulking that is coming off/peeling away needs to be removed and/or replaced.

ACT 207(b) / 21.21b

Prior unsatisfactory was corrected. The kennel owner sealed or covered any exposed wood that the dogs may come in contact with.

ACT 207(b) / 21.24d (3)

There were pens that had wire flooring that allowed the dogs' feet to fall through the openings in the floor. This also poses a threat of injury to the dogs that if their legs fall through they could either get stuck or possibly result in a broken bone.

This warden directs: Replace the wire flooring with flooring that does not allow for the dogs' feet to pass through same.

ACT 207(b) / 21.28a

During the inspection there was food, accessible by the dogs, contaminated with feces.

This warden directs: Any contamination in the food must be removed as often as necessary to keep the food free from said contamination.

ACT 207(b) /21.28c

There were feeders that were either one or more of the following: contaminated with dog feces, dirty/caked with feed, or had cobwebs inside them.

This warden directs: Feeders need to be accessible to the dogs but located to avoid contamination with feces, kept clean, and sanitized regularly to prevent caking of feed.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29a

There were excessive amounts of feces under the dogs' pens. The kennel owner stated that the feces had not been removed for a couple of days because of snow.

This warden directs: Excreta shall be removed from the primary enclosure, including any floor area or ground surface beneath the primary enclosure, on a daily basis.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29b

The indoor boxes of the dogs' enclosures had an accumulation of debris, excreta, or disease hazard in corners, walls, and the floors.

This warden directs: Sanitize any and all portions of primary enclosures at a minimum of once daily, and as often as necessary to prevent an accumulation of debris or excreta or disease hazard.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29c

There were cobwebs and excessive amounts of hair/gunk built-up throughout the kennel.

This warden directs: The kennel owner used Ehrlich to rid of the mouse infestation. Cobwebs throughout the kennel shall be removed, and the kennel shall have the hair/gunk build-up removed to eliminate conditions that would allow or encourage infestation of insects, ectoparasites and avian and mammalian pests.



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ACT 207(b) / 21.30

Several of the dogs requested to be groomed were either no longer on the premises or had been clipped. During the inspection there were several dogs viewed that still had matting of the coat and long nails. There was also a Westie (F) viewed to have severe abrasion on the neck from the chain collar.

ACT 207(c) / 21.41a

The records viewed for adults in kennel did contain an accurate number of dogs counted in the kennel. They were viewed to be missing date of birth for dogs and/or date acquired. The records that contained the puppy information, there were pups listed on the records as still being in the kennel but were already sold, as illustrated in comparison with Bill of Sale information. There were dogs that were shown on Bill of Sale information to have already entered and left the kennel premises but were not listed on records as having been in the kennel at all. There were several dogs that were viewed on the puppy records and on the adult records as well.

This warden directs: Review and update all records with regards to and including all required information. Record an accurate count of the dogs that are in the kennel. Any dog that enters the kennel, whether through another person or whelped on premises shall be indicated on the records. Ensure that any dogs that are transferred from puppy records to adult records are removed from puppy records, so not to have double listings of dogs on records.

ACT 220

On the date of inspection, kennel owner stated that he did not have time to do an inspection at which time he refused inspection. The kennel owner subsequently threatened this officer. The state police were notified and subsequently spoke with the kennel owner along side of the wardens. The kennel owner decided to go ahead with the inspection.

This warden directs: Upon arrival of state dog wardens to the premises the kennel owner shall allow entry to the kennel/location where dogs are kept for the purpose of inspection.

ACT 401(c)

During the kennel inspection, upon notice of violations by wardens, the kennel owner attempted to make corrections and alter the conditions of the kennel before the wardens could indentify same.

This warden directs: During an inspection no persons shall perform any actions that would alter the condition of the kennel at the time of the inspection.

ACT402 (a)

An order of veterinary care was placed on the Westie. The examination was to be conducted before 3/10/2009.

ACT 402 (d)

The order of veterinary care was received by Dog Law on 3/9/2009 via fax, which directed for the area on the neck to be cleaned and applied with topical vet spray 3x/day and the collar to be removed.

This warden directs: Condition of Dogs: Remaining dogs with matted coats should be clipped to remove said mats. The nails on the dogs should be trimmed. Any dogs that show signs of infectious/contagious disease or abnormal conditions should be seen by a vet, and proof of care should be kept for verification.

ACT 603(b)

The bills of sale were viewed for several puppies that were sold under 8 weeks of age.

This warden directs: Refrain from selling dogs less than 8 weeks of age.

**Remarks**

A recheck inspection of the kennel was completed. There were a total of 99 adults and 37 puppies on the premises at the time of the inspection. The notice of refusal/revocation and notice of operating under suspension letters were both posted for display. The inspection was performed with Warden Kristen Donmoyer and Dr Griswold.

\*\*Any recommended actions listed may not be all that is required for the kennel owner to come into full compliance with all laws and regulations. It is the responsibility of the kennel owner to take any and all necessary measures to ensure compliance. \*\*

ACT 207(b) / REG 21.21a

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

The kennel owner, on the front side of the kennel where dogs were housed, had put strips of a PVC-type material along the top edge of all the door frames that covered the sharp edges of the wire. This adjustment made the door frame and door flush with one another such that the dogs were neither able to put their head between the door frame and door nor were their feet able to fall down between the door and the floor of the run. Boxes that were housing dogs had the caulking repaired/replaced.

This warden directs: If in the future the kennel owner would use the back side of the kennel that was not



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housing dogs at the time of the inspection, prior issues regarding the door gaps, sharp edges, caulking, etc. must be corrected. The boxes must also be sanitized before putting dogs in the enclosures.

ACT 207(b) / 21.22

Nearly every pen that was housing dogs contained dogs of the opposite sex.

This warden directs: All dogs shall be segregated by sex except for health, welfare or breeding reasons.

ACT 207(b) / 21.24d (3)

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

The pens that run along the front side of the kennel had panels of wire overlapping the pre-existing wire floor to prevent the dogs' feet from passing through the openings.

This warden directs: If in the future the kennel owner uses the portion of pens at back side of the kennel, the flooring in those pens shall not allow for the feet of any dog in those pens to pass through the openings of said flooring.

ACT 207(b) / 21.28a

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

There was no food, accessible by dogs, contaminated with feces.

ACT 207(b) /21.28c

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

There were no feeders viewed with any of the following: contaminated with dog feces, dirty/caked feed, or cobwebs inside.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29a

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

The kennel owner has removed excreta from the primary enclosure, including any floor area or ground surface beneath the primary enclosure.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29b

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

The primary enclosures were sanitized and cleaned to remove accumulation of debris, excreta, or disease hazard.

ACT 207(b) / 21.29c

Prior unsatisfactory has been corrected.

The kennel owner has removed the excessive amounts of hair/gunk build-up throughout the kennel.

ACT 207(b) / 21.30 Condition of dogs

During the inspection there were four (4) dogs, all Yorkies, viewed that had matting of the coat. There was a Yorkie (M) found to have extremely bad teeth, an excessive build -up of plaque, and possible tooth decay.

This warden directs: Clip the dogs' coat to remove the matting.

ACT402 (a)

An order of veterinary care was placed on the Yorkie.

ACT 402 (d)

The order of veterinary care was completed on 4/6/09 by Twin Valley Veterinary Clinic, Dr Stevenson.

This warden directs: Any dogs that show signs of infectious/contagious disease or abnormal conditions should be seen by a vet, and proof of care should be kept for verification.
