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Remarks

Inspection of kennel took place on February 27, 2009. A total of 305 adult dogs and 75 puppies were located on the premises at the time of inspection. Records not viewed at inspection. Inspection was performed with Wardens Buhl, Donmoyer, and Zeigler.

*** Actions directed to be taken below are not all that may be required of the kennel operator to come into compliance. The kennel operator is responsible for taking any and all actions necessary to come into compliance.

The inspection of February 27, 2009 is as follows:

21.24 (d) -

This Warden found areas where the dog's feet were passing through the wire.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Put floor mats in kennel boxes, where dogs are located, that will stop their feet from passing through the floor openings.

21.30 -

This Warden found dogs which had long nails and had hair matting.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The kennel owner needs to clip toe nails and groom all dogs in his kennel which need attention.

Additional comments:

This Warden was refused entry by kennel owner's wife because owner was not home. A search warrant was obtained to conduct inspection.

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Remarks

Inspection of kennel took place on March 26, 2009. A total of 274 adult dogs and 99 puppies were located on the premises at the time of inspection. The 2008 kennel license was viewed along with the 2009 kennel license refusal letter (posted in both kennel buildings). Viewed the rabies self certification letter and exemption letter allowing the owner to keep records on "unofficial" forms. Inspection was performed with Diane Buhl, Kristen Reed, and a State Veterinarian.

***Actions directed to be taken below are not all that may be required of the kennel operator to come into compliance. The kennel operator is responsible for taking any and all actions necessary to come into compliance.

The inspection of March 26, 2009 is as follows:

21.22 (c)/ 211 (C) (2)

There are approximately 33 adult male dogs on kennel premises, all of which are mixed into pens with adult female dogs. Wardens specifically noted 9 pens in the prefabricated kennel building which had male and female dogs in cages together.

This warden directs kennel owner take the following action(s):

While kennel is operating under suspension, all dogs must be segregated by sex; so as to prevent any further breeding of dogs.

21.24 (d)/ 207 (b)

Four of the whelping pens had puppies' feet that were falling through the wire flooring. One of the pens had an adult dog whose feet fell through the flooring in this warden's presence.

This warden directs kennel owner take the following action(s):

Obtain mats or smaller wire flooring that prevents puppies'/dogs' feet from falling through the wire flooring.

21.27/ 207 (b)

There was minimal light in the prefabricated kennel. Wardens needed flashlights to see the physical and sanitary condition of dogs located in the bottom row of kennel facility.

This warden directs kennel owner take the following action(s):

While the dogs have unfettered access to outdoor runs, the lighting inside where the dog boxes are located is not sufficient to allow observation of the dog's physical condition as well as the sanitary conditions those dogs live in.

21.28 (a)/ 207 (b)

In the prefabricated section of the kennel there were approximately 10 feeders that had food in them contaminated by old feces.

This warden directs kennel owner take the following action(s):

The food for dogs shall be free from contamination or disease. Do not just pull feces out of the feeder, because small pieces are left behind to get old and moldy and mix with the food. Instead if there is feces in a feeder, dump the food out of the receptacle, and wash it, and place new food back into the feeder.

21.30

Owner has started clipping dogs, there are still about half of the dogs yet that need to be clipped for matting and long toenails. One dog a Bichon Frise female located in pen (RB4) displayed signs of rear leg lameness.

This warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The dogs listed in the above aforementioned paragraph all exhibit signs of poor health; kennel owner shall provide proof of adequate veterinary care for the Bichon Frise dog listed above.

402 (d)

Veterinary examination was ordered on (1) dog under section 402(a) based on warden's observations of the condition of dogs during an inspection. Kennel is in compliance with section 402(d) because veterinary examinations were completed within the 72 hour time frame.
