A total of 37 adult dogs and 24 puppies were located on the premises at the time of inspection. Exemption letter to keep records on approved "unofficial" forms was viewed. Inspection was performed with Kristen Donmoyer and Robert Beck. The kennel sells dogs at retail.

21.21(a) - Maintenance

Wardens observed cracked open concrete flooring in large dog pen area. Broken window glass at floor level in whelping room.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Repair concrete flooring in a manner that dogs toenails cannot get caught in cracks. Replace broken glass in window.

21.21(b) Water Resistance

Some of the wooden surfaces in pens were not resistant to moisture.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):  
Maintain all porous surfaces so that they are water resistant

21.21(c) Drainage

Wardens observed puddles of what appeared to be urine in some of the dog pens.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):  
Provide adequate drainage to rapidly eliminate excess liquid from housing facility.

21.29(b) - Sanitation

Wardens observed an accumulation of dog hair and old dog food in puppy housing on floor along walls. Standing urine in large kennel area.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Primary enclosures where the dogs are housed indoors must be cleaned a minimum of once daily. Specifically, owner shall keep clean area where dog are kept.

21.29(c) - Housekeeping/pests

Wardens observed feces and debris under pens along walls and supports in whelping building as well as cobwebs in facility. There were bird droppings throughout large kennel area. There was a large open runoff area of urine & feces at large kennel area;

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The buildings and grounds of the kennel shall be maintained, kept cleaned and in good repair and to prevent avian or mammalian pests.

Space- Shelter all Dogs: 207(h)(2)(vii)

Wardens observed the primary enclosure did not provide sufficient space to shelter dogs housed in pens. Dog boxes were not large enough to house the size of the dogs in the pens.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Use primary enclosures that provide sufficient space to shelter any dogs housed in the primary enclosure at one time.

Space - Free movement: 207(h)(2)(xi)

Wardens observed primary enclosures measuring 3 feet by 6 feet with 2 dogs measuring 36" each. Dogs could not turn about freely or lie in a normal position.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Provide space to allow each dog to turn about freely and to stand, sit and lie in a normal position. The dog must be able to lie down while fully extended without the dogs head, tail, legs, face or feet touching any side of the enclosure.

Space - Height: 207(h)(2)(xii)

Wardens observed primary enclosures that did not have enough height to house size of dogs in enclosure.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The interior height of a primary enclosure shall be at least six inches higher than the head of the tallest dog in the enclosure when it is in a normal standing position.

Primary Enclosure- Structural - (h)(9)

Wardens observed unsealed porous concrete block and unsealed plywood on interior of primary enclosures.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Seal walls and plywood in primary enclosures.

Space - Size of Primary Enclosure: 207(i)(1)

Wardens measured a 33" Shepherd in a 3.5 foot by 4 foot primary enclosure equaling 14 square feet and two dogs measuring 36" in a 6 foot by 3 foot primary enclosure equaling 18 square feet.

This Warden directs that the kennel owner take the following action(s):

(1) A dog housed in a primary enclosure must be provided a minimum amount of floor space in the primary enclosure, calculated as provided under this subparagraph: Find the mathematical square of the sum of the length of the dog in inches, measured in a straight line from the tip of its nose to the base of its tail, plus six inches, then divide the product by 144, then multiply by 2. The calculation is: (length of dog in inches + 6)(length of dog in inches + 6) = required floor space in square inches. Required floor space in inches/144 x 2 = required floor space in square feet. For the second dog placed in the primary enclosure the minimum floor space shall be doubled. The floor space shall be calculated using the longest dog. For each dog above two, the minimum floor space shall be multiplied by 1.5 per additional dog.

Sanitation: 207(h)(2)(ix); (h)(14)(i); (h)(14)(iii); (h)(14)(v); (h)(14)(vi); (h)(14)(vii)

Wardens observed an accumulation of dog hair and old dog food in puppy housing on floor along walls. Standing urine in and just outside large kennel area. Debris, bird droppings, algae, chewed wood in kennels.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Premises where primary enclosures are located, including buildings and surrounding grounds, must be kept clean and in good repair. Premises must be kept free of accumulations of waste products and free of avian droppings. Repair or replace all chewed wood and waterproof any porous areas.

Exercise Area - Size: 207(i)(6) (ii)

Wardens observed exercise area measuring 84 square feet for 2 dogs requiring 98 square feet.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

The exercise area must be at least twice the size of the primary enclosure requirements for size of one dog plus required additional space for any additional dogs.

Exercise Area - Sanitation: 207(i)(6)(v)

Wardens observed puddles of urine in exercise area as well as avian waste.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Keep area clean as required.

Exercise Area - Nursing Dams: 207(i)(6)(viii)

Wardens observed inadequate exercise area for nursing dams and their puppies.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Provide proper exercise area for nursing bitches and their puppies as required.

Exercise Area - Structure and Maintenance: 207(i)(6)(ix)

Wardens observed no on ground exercise area for nursing dams.

This Warden directs the kennel owner take the following action(s):

Nursing bitches and puppies must have exercise area on ground level.
