HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Structure; construction. Housing facilities for dogs must be designed and constructed so that they are structurally sound. They must be kept in good repair, and they must protect the animals from injury, contain the animals securely, and restrict other animals from entering.

The following structural items were noted on this inspection:

- (1) The linoleum is curling up along the west wall exposing the wooden floor in the upper indoor dog room.
- (2) There is a section of plywood floor which has popped up in the hallway in the outdoor shed building.

The floor needs to be repaired in the above two locations to allow for cleaning and to restrict pests from entering.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

Storage. Supplies of food and bedding must be stored in a manner that protects the supplies from spoilage, contamination, and vermin infestation. The supplies must be stored off the floor and away from the walls, to allow cleaning underneath and around the supplies. All open supplies of food and bedding must be kept in leakproof containers with tightly fitting lids to prevent contamination and spoilage.

There is an open bag of dog food on the floor in the outdoor shed building. All open supplies of food need to be stored in leakproof containers with lids to protect supplies from contamination.

CLEANING, SANITIZATION, HOUSEKEEPING, AND PEST CONTROL.

Pest control. An effective program for the control of insects, external parasites affecting dogs and cats, and birds and mammals that are pests, must be established and maintained so as to promote the health and well-being of the animals and reduce contamination by pests in animal areas.

There are small flies accumulating in front of the outdoor runs by the gravel. An effective control for flies is needed in this area. Keeping the gravel area free of wet bedding and debris should help with the fly problem. This item affects 21 dogs.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Primary enclosures must be constructed and maintained so that they have no sharp points or edges that could injure the dogs.

Outdoor enclosure housing 2 labrador retrievers and 1 labradoodle has a hole in the chink-link wire above the water bowl on the front door. Wire is bent around the hole. Chain-link wire needs to be repaired to prevent possible injury to the dogs.
