

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HYPOGLYCEMIA

Hypoglycemia is a low sugar level in the blood. This can happen if any animal or human does not intake enough nutrition and keep their blood sugar at a normal level. In puppies and kittens, this can result in "sugar shock". Frequently this condition occurs when a puppy suffers stress, such as weaning from their mother, being separated from littermates, over handling, or relocating to a new home. Sugar shock is easily prevented, but if not attended to quickly can be life threatening.

Symptoms to look for include listlessness, depression, pale or white gums, staggering, and refusal to eat. If the puppy or kitten does not receive treatment the problem can progress to more serious complications such as vomiting, diarrhea, and in some cases seizures and death. Toy breeds are more likely to incur hypoglycemic shock. Chihuahuas, Malteses', Yorkies', Pomeranians and any mix of these breeds are easy candidates.

To ensure that your puppy or kitten does not have any problems, you need to keep a very close eye on them! Feed the puppy/kitten accordingly, and try to keep them on the same feeding routine the store had them on. Do not let them skip any meals! If they seem like they are not hungry, wait a little while and try to feed again. If nothing still, try alternate types of food mixed with their own. You can add jarred baby food (chicken, beef, or lamb), other types of canned puppy or kitten food, cooked ground beef, boiled chicken, boiled white rice, or canned pumpkin pie mix. Try adding warm water to the food, or heating the food in the microwave. We always recommend using a high-calorie paste supplement during the first few days/weeks in the puppy/kittens' new home. You can add the supplement right to their food, or administer it with your finger. You can never give too much- so for the first few days, we recommend it at least 3 times a day, especially before bedtime as this condition happens more frequently at night.

It is very important to take your puppy to your regular Veterinarian as soon as you suspect any of the symptoms arising. It's also important to rule out any other problems with similar symptoms such as Parvovirus, Coronavirus, parasites, or liver malfunctions. Coccidia and Giardia are parasites in the intestine that can become active when the puppy or kitten is under stress and can cause diarrhea that may have mucous or blood in it. This is very common, and is easily treated with medication.

Be sure to take your new puppy/kitten to your regular Veterinarian within the warranty period of 7 days. This is vital to ensure the health of your new pet, and to rule out any problems early.

I have read the above information XKD. I also understand that Pets Plus nor Household Pet Protection, Inc. is responsible for hypoglycemia after the sale of the puppy or kitten is finalized, as they cannot be responsible for my pet not eating. It is our policy not to send any of our animals home unless they are eating well at the time of sale.



To whom it may concern:

presented to our hospital on September 10, 2008 for vomiting, diarrhea and lethargy. We tested her for parvovirus for which she almost immediately tested a strong positive. She was referred to the emergency hospital for further supportive care and diagnostics.

Parvovirus is transmitted through the feces of an infected dog. The incubation period for the virus is 7-14 days and clinical signs of the virus begin to manifest 6-10 days post infection. It is thus indicated that Patches was exposed to parvovirus prior to her purchase by the owners.
